

## Terms & Conditions

By registering for the Warsaw Model United Nations Conference 2016 (WawMUN 2016), Delegates agree to the following terms and conditions:

### General Rules

1. All registered delegates must be enrolled at a high school or a university at the time of WawMUN 2016 conference (October 2016).
2. All delegates under the age of 18 years are advised to be accompanied by a supervisor. Teachers, parents, university students and other individuals of 18 years old or older are eligible to be a supervisor.
3. WawMUN 2016 seeks to create a friendly and respectful community. Any harassment or discrimination based on factors such as but not limited to: gender, race, sexual orientation, disability, nationality, religion is strictly forbidden. The Secretary General or other organisers, appointed by him/her have the authority to expel a Delegate from the WawMUN 2016 Conference if such punishment is considered appropriate by them.
4. All Delegates must abide by the Rules of Procedure during the Committee Sessions and the General Assembly. Should a Delegate fail to comply with the Rules of Procedure, his/her participation in the Conference may be limited at the discretion of the Secretary General, the President of the General Assembly or the Delegate's Chair.
5. English shall be the only working language of WawMUN 2016 conference.
6. Delegates are expected to arrive on time at the Conference, this including the Opening Ceremony, Committee Sessions, and the General Assembly. Failing to arrive on time may limit Delegate's participation in the Conference.
7. All Delegates are required to avoid actions which can pose risk to the safety at the Conference.
8. Western business attire or national attire of the represented country are suitable apparel during the Conference.
9. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, the Delegate recognises that the organisers of WawMUN 2016 shall have a right to publish and distribute any photos or movies taken during the Conference, even if they include an image of the Delegate.

### Registration & Payment

10. The registration is conducted via MyMun.net platform. Possession of a free account on MyMun.net is crucial for a Delegate to be able to register.

11. All Delegates are obliged to pay a fee of 60 EUR / 250 PLN. Delegates registering from Poland must pay their fees in PLN. No other currencies shall be accepted. The fee is requested within 10 days after being accepted to the conference. If this period is exceeded, Delegate's assignment will not have to be given upon his/her preferences.
12. The Conference fee is non-refundable. If the Delegate cancels his/her participation in the Conference for any reason after transferring the fee, the organisers of WawMUN 2016 will not be able to refund the fee. If the Delegate is expelled from the Conference for breaking Terms & Conditions, or if his/her participation in the Conference is limited, the fee will not be refunded.
13. Only after submitting a bank transfer confirmation to the organisers of WawMUN 2016 is the Delegate's post at the Conference certain. Before paying the fee, the Delegates are asked to wait for an e-mail confirming their successful registration.
14. Organisers of WawMUN 2016 cannot guarantee that every Delegate receives a post in accordance with his/her declared preferences.
15. Free accommodation in host families is offered to the Delegates arriving from outside Warsaw. The number of places is limited, and the organisers of WawMUN 2016 cannot guarantee that every willing Delegate will be assigned free accommodation.
16. The organisers of WawMUN 2016 may refuse to register a Delegate basing on his/her insufficient merit.

### Liability

17. During the Conference, all the Delegates are obliged to abide by Polish law. If the organisers of WawMUN 2016 register any aberration of Polish law, such as usage of drugs or other illegal substances, appropriate service will be informed.
18. Delegates are personally responsible for all charges and damage to facilities at the Conference venues, this including Social Events venues.
19. Delegates are required to obey the Intellectual Property laws at all times during the Conference.
20. WawMUN 2016 organisers do not take any responsibility for the Delegates' damaging actions or breaking of any laws.
21. No alcohol is allowed during the Conference, except for the Social Event, when the alcohol is allowed for individuals who are at least 18 years old (according to Polish legal policies).
22. Delegates arriving from abroad are advised to purchase a healthcare insurance for the period of their stay in Poland. WawMUN 2016 organisers do not provide any insurance for Delegates.

### Final provisions

23. The Secretary General of WawMUN 2016 can modify the Terms & Conditions at any time (excluding provisions regarding the Conference fee).
24. The Secretary General and the President of General Assembly can modify the Rules of Procedure at any time.
25. All the information published on [www.wawmun.pl](http://www.wawmun.pl), including the Conference Agenda, is subject to change.
26. The organisers of WawMUN 2016 are not responsible for any erroneous statements by unauthorised Staff members.
27. In special cases, the Secretary General can apply exceptions to these Terms & Conditions.
